On behalf of our caregivers, patients and their families who are benefitting from your generosity, we extend our heartfelt gratitude.

As we all know, COVID is alive and too-well in Michigan and across the world. Testing at the Frandor drive-thru testing site is increasing dramatically; those caregivers are working 7-days/week, and testing has begun at two other sites in town, as well. Our lab has gone from running 300 tests per day at the beginning of this pandemic to more than 2,000 per day as recently as last week.

For nearly 125 years, Sparrow has served the people of this region. Your in-kind contributions of materials, labor and more are a testament to what community healthcare truly means.
